ASKING FOR A LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION

- ◆ **ASK** a teacher, counselor, community member, employer, etc. **WHO KNOWS YOU WELL!** (No family members or peers!)
- ◆ Give at least **2 WEEKS** notice to the person you're asking to prepare your letter of recommendation.
- ◆ Request your letter of recommendation **IN PERSON**.
- ◆ In addition to telling your recommender your deadlines & logistics, give them thoughtful reflections of your values, goals & accomplishments. Provide a copy of your resume, too.
- ◆ Be sure to **THANK** your recommender for writing a letter of recommendation for you.

FREE ACT TEST PRACTICE

- Log onto academy.act.org
- Click on "Access Student Learning Resources"
- Click on "Get the Free Study Guide" OR "Prueba de práctica libre" for a Free Practice Test & Study Guide that includes a full-length practice test; Overview of the ACT test & what to expect on tests day; & Access to general test-taking strategies
- OR Click on "Get the ACT Online Practice Test" to take official ACT practice tests in all 4 subject areas; Know exactly what you missed & what you didn't with a score report; Access related resources to improve your skills based on what you missed; & Retake the test as many times as you want
- IF you have already created an ACT account, just sign in OR click on "Create MyACT account" . If you have taken the ACT before or took it at South HS, you will click on "I registered or tested before". You will need your ACT Student ID # to do this.

- ◆ **KEEP** all usernames, passwords, pin codes, & your FSA ID # in a safe place (*NOT only in your phone*) as you will be using these often during your senior year!
- ◆ Be sure the email address listed for your parent(s)/guardian(s) is current on Infinite Campus!
- ◆ **Do NOT pay for any scholarship(s) or financial aid! See your counselor with any questions. Be aware of scams!**
